


## 2016 Wineshow

The Australian Highlands Wine Show is open to all Australian wines made from grapes sourced from vineyards above 500 metres in altitude. A record 154 entries were received this year with the highest recorded medal awarded with particular comment from judges highlighting the exceptional standard of wines entered.

These regions can include Southern Highlands NSW, Orange NSW, Mudgee NSW, New England NSW, Tumbarumba NSW, Hilltops NSW, Gundagai NSW, Canberra District NSW & ACT, Adelaide Hills SA, Beechworth VIC, Strathbogie Ranges VIC, Macedon Ranges VIC and Granite Belt QLD

## Memorial Trophies

### **The Leslie Fritz Trophy for Best Riesling in show**

When Leslie Fritz bought a Southern Highlands property in 1987 at the sprightly age of 80, he used his vision and experience to plant the regions second vineyard in 1990 mainly comprised of his beloved Riesling variety. Leslie Fritz, and the Eling Forest Winery and Vineyards exemplify Leslie's work and vision that the Southern Highlands has developed into a well known, respected and awarded wine region with a growing economy.

A passion for excellence and innovation helped transform these early vineyards in the Southern Highlands region and Leslie Fritz's legacy remains and impacts on the wine industry in the Southern Highlands to this day. His ideas transformed the art of wine making, and his vision helped the region develop into the dynamic and profitable tourist destination it is today. We recognise Leslie Fritz's passion and commitment with the trophy for Best Riesling in show.

### **The Kim Moginie Trophy for Best Red Wine Blend in show**

Kim Moginie was the modern pioneer of the Southern Highlands wine region when he and his wife Frances planted the first modern vineyard in 1983 at Joadja. The regions first planting was comprised of Sauvignon Blanc, malbec, Pinot Blanc and Cabernet Sauvignon varieties.

We recognise Kim's passion for blazing a trail that many have followed in recent years with their own enthusiasm for cool climate wines from the high altitudes of the Southern Highlands. Kim's particular passion for unique red wines and blends is a legacy we acknowledge with the trophy for best red wine blend in show
